

- Internal legal support

Committee of Informal Inquiry (CII)

- Council Members
- Pro-forma complainant pharmacist
- No legal representation
 - Informal proceedings Q&A


Committee of Formal Inquiry (CFI)

Grade C Inspections

When are Grade C inspections handed over for disciplinary investigation?

- No pharmacist present during inspection
- No Responsible pharmacist registered with the SAPC
- Second or more Grade C inspection
- What can a RP do to avoid disciplinary?
 - Answer your inspection shortcomings online
 - Do the self assessment
 - Attend to administration issues like the registration of a RP

Transgression Trends

Dispensing errors (Community and Institutional)

- bad handwriting on prescriptions,
- similarities in product names,
- similar packaging
- GPP shortcomings (Grade C pharmacies)
 - Study done by NWU show that as a general rule industry is compliant in terms of GPP
 - Attitude that SAHPRA will pick up more problems in inspections than SAPC
- Operating pharmacies without pharmacists/Responsible Pharmacists
 - Applying as RP automatically removes you as RP from previous pharmacy
- Responsible Pharmacists not having the correct systems in place to avoid errors or support staff working outside of scope of practice
 - Taking control and responsibility













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
